The £8.8million project to revitalise and regenerate the Bedford Bus Station area will deliver a modern, fit for purpose and welcoming gateway into Bedford town centre.

A new surface car park and public toilets have already been opened and work is continuing to improve Allhallows multi-storey car park.

Bus Stop Changes

We have worked closely with operators and bus user groups in order to try and minimise the impact on bus users. The majority of bus services will continue to pick up and drop off from within the bus station forecourt and stops have been grouped together by destination.

Disabled Parking Bays

The number of disabled parking bays in the town centre remains the same and designated bays have been added to Greyfriars Surface Car Park. In addition, those displaying a valid blue badge can continue to park for free in other car parks as well as at various on-street locations.

Taxi Ranks

These interim changes maintain taxi ranks in prominent town centre locations, close to shops and Bedford High Street.

A New Bus Station for Bedford




The next phase of the project to build the new Bedford Bus Station starts on Monday 27th January.
